- Assist in training, mentoring and evaluating other instructors and volunteers of special population and generally healthy strength & conditioning programs.
- Provide general consultations to members and/or patrons.
- Provide personal training services to clients who require a Clinical Exercise Physiologist due to their health status or those apparently healthy looking for general strength and conditioning programs.
- Instruct drop-in group fitness classes.
- Assist with individual and group fitness assessments, including occupational fitness testing or general fitness appraisals.
