We place importance on and value establishing spaces that foster social connection to increase a sense of community and belonging among New Brunswick's older adult community.

HISTORY OF THE GAMES

The NB 55+ Games were officially formed in 1992 as the governing body responsible for organizing sporting events aimed at promoting active living for individuals 55 and older. This initiative led to the inaugural NB 55+ Games in 1993, hosted in Saint John, marking the beginning of a beloved tradition that continues to thrive today.
